President's Report:

- 2020 Retreat: Ouray Ranch
 - August 21-23 has been secured: there are 8 rooms that usually accommodate 12 people. However, we will limit occupancy to 1 person/room (except spouses). Brian may have additional rooms available.
 - So far, only 5 signed up with deposits; John C will attend
 - How will we arrange a safe environment for the Lodge:
 - Social distancing
 - Masks when not eating
 - Single room occupancy
 - Meals: John C will arrange and cook meals (Brian volunteered to help). Rather than buffet style, individual meals will be served.
 - John Vevurka working on Edgewater
 - Allen contacted Kirk Klanke: we can fish on his Ranch Creek property (stream and stocked pond)
 Friday 8/21; 2 in am, 2 in pm
 - Jim Klug arranged Pietz property was moved to Saturday Aug 22. 2 fishers in the am, 2 in pm
 Pietz has terminal cancer.
 - Brian will take a group into RMNP Saturday 8/22
 - Will be requiring deposits to cover anticipated costs: \$200/person; send checks to Allen. Priority for fishing beats will be determined based on the order deposits are received.
 - Granby Trails: Jim K was able to arrange: 8/21, 8/22, and 8/23
 - Will also invite Ray Carney, Rudy Schreider, and Tom Corr. Depending on availability, these will be sent out 7/8 Allen has invited Kirk and Scott Lynn to Saturday dinner
- o Bill Stone passing: Bill was a long time CCTU member well liked in the community. A memorial has been posted on our social media.

 - -John A working on Western River Conservancy speaker: out of Washington DC; pending ? Mike Gotlieb; Lake City area: John A to preview his presentation before making a decision

- Brian will reach out to Chip Swanson (Winter Fly Fishing) Barbara Rust from TU: John A to contact
- John A will reach out to Barbara Rick, School of Mines, re possible presentation on effects of climate change on high altitude fishing. Also reach out to "The Bug Guy"

Conservation Programs/other events: George

- Cheeseman Canyon/River Rangers: Scott
 - Sign placement. Scott was able to have the sign installed. Unfortunately, it was small and contained a typo. A replacement sign was installed. There was some concern that this was too small. Larger signs revised signs, each 3x4', were estimated to cost \$700: It was agreed that the current sign is adequate, and no further signage will be installed.
 - Map Sign: this is old and outdated. And needs improvement. Scott will contact Dorsey about Blue Quill
 and CCTU sharing the cost of a new map sign. Sharon Lance has also been involved with this.
 - Communications from Nickum: last communication from him was 6/25 about working with the Forest Service on this. Waiting to hear more.
- <u>Spearfishing initiative:</u> John Egan (guest, Bull Moose Committee). John presented the CPW proposal to potentially allow spearfishing. This is in early discussions, and there will be plenty of time to respond. Nickum is communicating with CPW and probably will have something in the next couple of weeks. A final decision is expected in November.
- Alma Foundation: George
 - o A 2020 donation of \$8,000 was approved: ON HOLD AS YOUTH PROJECTS MAY NOT MATERIALIZE
 - o George has updated information, which he presented. Although a project similar to 2019 is not possible, the Youth Crew will be modified and trail work will begin soon. Other components of the project are also moving forward. As a result of this project is was voted to release the previously approved \$8,000 as a restricted grant with the stipulation that the funds be appropriated and used in 2020.
- CUSP: requested grant for blocking social trails and planting willows on main stem of S Platte: \$2000 approved: ON HOLD AS WE HAVE YET TO HEAR BACK FROM THEM
- Bear Creek Earth Day Project: \$1,600 was approved at the planning meeting: ON HOLD PENDING RESCHEDULING
 OF THE EVENT
- Clear Creek cleanup event: Communication from Jim K: it looks like the event may need to be cancelled. A decision with be forthcoming.
- Conservation T-shirts: \$1400 was approved at the planning meeting
- Forest Service: adopt a stream Jim R: Being pulled together now by USFS: pending
 - River Watch Jim R
 - \$300 approved for 2020 equipment: funded
- Youth Education/Education: All [not discussed]
 - Grant Compton, Eagle Scout Project: Scott

- TU National legal defense funds:
 - We need to send two separate checks made out to "Trout Unlimited: and use the following codes in the memo line so they are deposited correctly:
 - Bristol Bay/Pebble Mine \$5,000: Bristol Bay BBAYUN: Funded
 - Waters of the United States \$10,000: Clean Water Act PISCES: WILL PUT ON HOLD FOR NOW

- Presentation of Financial reports through 4/30/2020
 - o Current cash is \$38,681
 - o Patrick and Todd have filed the Annual Report to TU
 - o Financial report to the State is not due until end of August.
 - o Volunteer hours are needed: There is a new form Patrick will send out for Board members to complete

Fund Raising/Giving:

- Radowear: We have a new corporate sponsor: Radowear.com They make fishing clothes, etc. with Colorado logo.
 John A to interface
- River Traditions (Highland, MI): owner David Humphries contacted Allen about donation and sale of his products. This could be a (small) source of additional income to the Chapter. Board agreed to purchase 10 fly boxes and 20 keychain-s, all etched with CCTU and TU logo. ? something to continue

- Annual Fundraiser 2020: Peter
 - Peter King is leading the 2020 Fundraising effort: committee to include Allen, Ray, John A, George, Richard, and Ken Ray.
 - In the event the scheduled August 18: The plan is to have the event as scheduled
 - Peter has not yet gotten the permit from the City of Littleton for the picnic. As we will be having the event as planned, Peter will peruse the final permits.
 - What will the venue look like:
 - Social distancing / masks required
 - People to bring their own food/beverage/chairs/tables

- Limit to 50: Brian will send out social media message to RSVP. We will attempt some sort of virtual meeting as well.
- Johnathan Walters: will have a fly casting program
- Raffle Master: does a raffle master need to be present? [Following the meeting Allen contacted Jerry Shin. The regulation is that a raffle master does need to be present. Jerry said that he will attend.]
- Promotion of ticket sales:
 - So far, have sold 101 tickets (67% of goal)
 - Offers to purchase tickets have been sent to past purchasers: still following up on those
 - o On line tickets sales: Peter
 - State law prohibits deducting a fee from the raffle ticket price at the time of purchase; you need to add that on to the price. Alternatively, there are ways of paying back the fees later, but this is complex. CTU has figured it out. We'll pursue in 2021.
 - However, until recently we were unaware of this rule (the regulations are not posted on the SOS web site) and CTU just published these regulations a few weeks ago. Subsequently, we have suspended all credit card/square card raffle ticket sales in a good faith effort to fall into compliance.
 - Nevertheless, our current financial statements will reflect this oversight, and it's unclear
 how we are supposed to deal with this. Patrick expressed his reluctance to file the return
 with his name associated with it.

ACTION: Peter will contact Shannon Bee, SOS office, with whom he has had prior communications. We need advice on how to proceed.
