President's Report:

- 2020 Retreat: Ouray Ranch CANCELLED
 - After further consideration, it was decided (by email exchange) to cancel the Retreat. It was felt that the indoor environment at the Lodge would not be conducive to safety regarding COVID
 - Five had signed up with deposits; Todd is arranging to return each person's \$200 deposit
 - Allen contacted Kirk Klanke: we can fish on his Ranch Creek property (stream and stocked pond)
 Friday 8/21; 2 in am, 2 in pm: That opportunity still remains. Contact Allen if you are interested.
 - Jim Klug arranged Pietz property was moved to Saturday Aug 22. 2 fishers/8 hr beat. \$65/rod. Based on the "queue" at the time of preparing the agenda, Peter King and Rich Hus will fish there. Contact Jim K for details.
 - Granby Trails: Jim K was able to arrange: 8/21, 8/22, and 8/23: this has not fished well and will not be reserved.

Conservation Programs/other events: George

- Cheeseman Canyon/River Rangers : Scott
 - Communications from Nickum: last communication from him was 6/25 about working with the Forest Service on this. Waiting to hear more.
 - Supposed to start in August Scott to check and report back to the group on status

- <u>Spearfishing initiative:</u> John Egan sent his final summary from the Bull Moose committee. After 1-2 rounds of revisions, the CCTU board is good to forward our response along to CTU. Jim Rasmussen forwarded our response to CTU.
- Other Bull Moose Committee business Colorado's Energy /Future...a response to the 2020 rule on oil and gas site permits. George to follow up with John Egan to get more info.
- Alma Foundation: George
 - o George has updated information, which he presented. Although a project similar to 2019 is not possible, the Youth Crew will be modified and trail work will begin soon. Other components of the project are also moving forward. As a result of this project is was voted to release the previously approved \$8,000 as a restricted grant with the stipulation that the funds be appropriated and used in 2020. Check has been sent
- CUSP: requested grant for blocking social trails and planting willows on main stem of S Platte: \$2000 approved: No new info from CUSP. George to reengage CUSP on status.
- Bear Creek Earth Day Project: \$1,600 was approved at the planning meeting: ON HOLD PENDING RESCHEDULING
 OF THE EVENT
- Clear Creek cleanup event: Communication from Jim K: it looks like the event may need to be cancelled. A decision with be forthcoming.
- **Conservation T**-shirts: \$1400 was approved at the planning meeting. Shirts are in inventory and will be held until next year's projects.
- Forest Service: adopt a stream Jim R: Being pulled together now by USFS: pending
 - River Watch Jim R
 - \$300 approved for 2020 equipment: funded
- Youth Education/Education: All
 - Grant Compton, Eagle Scout Project: Scott
 - Unfortunately, Grant was not able to pursue to the project and it was cancelled.
- TU National legal defense funds:
 - We need to send two separate checks made out to "Trout Unlimited: and use the following codes in the memo line so they are deposited correctly:
 - Bristol Bay/Pebble Mine \$5,000: Bristol Bay BBAYUN: Funded
 - Waters of the United States \$10,000: Clean Water Act PISCES: On hold. Question was raised whether we should roll the \$10k into the Bristol Bay initiative. John Aaron stated that now is not the time and TU not asking for more funding for that project currently.

- Patrick announced he is stepping down following the Raffle Program as Co-Treasuer. He has been giving an ownership opportunity in an additional business, which does not allow the time he needs for CTU. Brian and Allen to discuss workload with Todd and assess whether additional resources are needed.
- Presentation of Financial reports through 7/31/2020
 - o Current cash is \$32,007
 - o Financial Quarterly report to the State was completely by Patrick and submitted by Allen.
 - o Volunteer hours are needed: There is a new form Patrick sent it out for Board members to complete

Fund Raising/Giving:

- Radowear: We have a new corporate sponsor: Radowear.com They make fishing clothes, etc. with Colorado logo.
 John A to interface
- Annual Fundraiser 2020: Peter
 - Peter King is leading the 2020 Fundraising effort: committee to include Allen, Ray, John A, George, Richard, and Ken Ray.
 - In the event the scheduled August 18: The event will go on as planned.
 - Peter has received the final permit from the City of Littleton for the picnic. As we will be having the event as planned,
 - What will the venue look like:
 - Social distancing / masks required
 - People to bring their own food/beverage/chairs/tables
 - Limit to 50: Social media on the event has been out for several months. Additional newsletter info will go out this week. We will attempt some sort of virtual meeting as well.
 - Johnathan Walters: will have a fly casting program
 - Raffle Master: does a raffle master need to be present? The regulation is that a raffle master does need to be present. Jerry initially said he could attend, but a conflict arose and he cannot. Alex Spiecer has been contacted. Can Stephanie attend? Can the raffle master "be present" via Zoom?
 - o John Cristantiello has arranged a Food Truck with 5 menu items...will help minimize folks bringing their own food...Brian will add to the newsletter and social media and website events.
 - "To Do" list for raffle: Peter to finalize
 - Raffle tickets: Peter, George, and Allen have all of the tickets and will bring those. Should reconcile the lists for accuracy. Need a jug to draw from
 - Prizes:
 - Peter has ?most/all of the prizes
 - Should be labeled
 - Certificates printed and placed in labeled envelopes

- Drawing:
 - Draw in ascending order of retail value
 - Need 2 people keeping track of prize winners. Folks who claim prizes at the event need to sign off. Peter to identify.
 - Mention to winners that prizes can be traded, although the Chapter will not facilitate that.
- Promotion of ticket sales:
 - So far, have sold 122 tickets (81% of goal)
 - Offers to purchase tickets have been sent to past purchasers:
 - On line tickets sales: Peter
 - State law prohibits deducting a fee from the raffle ticket price at the time of purchase; you need to add that on to the price. Alternatively, there are ways of paying back the fees later, but this is complex. CTU has figured it out. We'll pursue in 2021.
 - However, until recently we were unaware of this rule (the regulations are not posted on the SOS web site) and CTU just published these regulations a few weeks ago. Subsequently, we have suspended all credit card/square card raffle ticket sales in a good faith effort to fall into compliance.
 - Nevertheless, our current financial statements will reflect this oversight, and it's unclear
 how we are supposed to deal with this. Patrick expressed his reluctance to file the return
 with his name associated with it.

ACTION: Peter was able to negotiate a "deal" with Shannon Bee, SOS office. We were given a "waiver" for on line credit card sales for the 2nd Quarter of 2020. There were a handful of online ticket sales in early July (3rd quarter). WHAT IS STATUS OF THAT?
