Membership Meetings:

- Currently Cresthill is closed. School opening is currently "on hold"
 - Right now, we don't know when in person meetings can resume. We should be planning for online
 meeting. Need to keep the membership engaged. Wil continue with Zoom meeting with George as
 host. Stephanie communicated to Allen about a new fee structure which would increase our annual
 rental to about \$2K. Allen had questions, but has not heard back. Brian stated that he would get information from Stephanie and report back.

- -John A working on Western River Conservancy speaker: out of Washington DC; pending ? Mike Gotlieb; Lake City area: John A to preview his presentation before making a decision
- Brian will reach out to Chip Swanson (Winter Fly Fishing)
- Ashley Rust from TU: John A to contact
- John A will reach out to Barbara Rick, School of Mines, re possible presentation on effects of climate change on high altitude fishing. Also reach out to "The Bug Guy"

Conservation Programs/other events: George

- Cheeseman Canyon/River Rangers : Scott
 - Communications from Nickum: last communication from him was 6/25 about working with the Forest Service on this. Scott sent email to Nickum requesting status. Waiting to hear more.
 - Supposed to start in August Scott to check and report back to the group on status
- Spearfishing initiative: John Egan sent his final summary from the Bull Moose committee. There was mention
 of CCTU writing a letter to CPW; Jim R sent a letter to Nickum. The issues appears to be dead in the water for
 now.
- Other Bull Moose Committee business Colorado's Energy /Future...a response to the 2020 rule on oil and gas site permits. George to follow up with John Egan to get more info. Comments can be submitted https://colora-dotu.org/blog/2020/8/take-action-ensure-responsible-energy-development-with-safeguards-for-wildlife-fish-and-their-habitat
 - CTU will encourage the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) to extend the "no ground disturbance" protection from 300 ft. to ¼ mile.
 - John E will distribute sample LTE for the Colorado Sun and HR papers.
 - CTU will issue a "statement of fact" regarding new regulations requiring and fishing/hunting license in order to access State Wildlife areas.

- Peter asked if Cheesman Canyon could be designated a SWA; he will pursue.
- <u>Headwaters Chapter:</u> Allen and Jim K have been in contact with Kirk Klancke, president of HC. Their fundraising efforts were reduced by nearly 2/3 due to COVID. They have ongoing projects that require funding in order to be maintained (e.g. river monitoring). Would CCTU consider a donation? Could we divert some \$\$ previously earmarked for WOUS?
 - ACTION: After discussion, it was decided that the Headwaters Chapter should be invited to the October CCTU BOD meeting to present their needs. Decision to donate to their organization will be discussed following the presentation.
- Alma Foundation: George
- <u>CUSP</u>: requested grant for blocking social trails and planting willows on main stem of S Platte: \$2000 approved: No new info from CUSP. George to reengage CUSP on status. There may be an effort to plant more trees on Horse Creek
- Bear Creek Earth Day Project: \$1,600 was approved at the planning meeting: ON HOLD PENDING RE-SCHEDULING OF THE EVENT: probably no project this yer
- Clear Creek cleanup event: J Klug Event was cancelled.
- Conservation T-shirts: J Klug \$300 was raised from sales at the raffle drawing event
- Forest Service: adopt a stream Jim R: Being pulled together now by USFS: pending River Watch – Jim R
- Youth Education/Education: All
 - Eagle Scout Project per CTU: Scott
 - Did anything ever materialize. Scott has not heard back on this.
- Granby Electroshocking: Jim Klug announced the Granby will be conducting electroshocking on 9/2/20. Meet at the Granby Firehouse at 8:30 am.
- TU National legal defense funds:
 - CCTU had budgeted \$15,000 to TU National to support lobbying efforts and legal fees. We need to send
 two separate checks made out to "Trout Unlimited: and use the following codes in the memo line so they
 are deposited correctly:
 - Bristol Bay/Pebble Mine \$5,000: Bristol Bay BBAYUN: Funded
 - Waters of the United States \$10,000: Clean Water Act PISCES: Was on hold pending outcome of fundraising. Would this be needed with an Administration change? It was decided to hold up on the donation for now.
