President's Report

- CCTU BOARD OF DIRECTORS
 - CCTU BOD make-up
 - o Two new Board members (Meg and Cory) have been added in the past two months
 - John Aaron will be moved to Emeritus Director status
 - Current BOD make-up 10 Board Members, 12 Emeritus Board Members, majority 6 required for quorum
- South Platte Enhancement Board Grant Proposal
 - CCTU was awarded a grant of \$40K for the purpose of Cheesman Canyon, Gill Trail restoration
 improvements. These funds (restricted) will be used "to hire a professional trail design firm to map and
 assess the existing Gill Trail conditions, and to provide recommendations for trail design improvements."

Conservation Programs

- South Platte River Corridor/Cheesman Canyon John E
 - CUSP Signage \$1250 to be paid in FY23. A total of 10 signs will be produced, currently in the design process via CUSP. For simplicity, all the signs will be identical, thus CCTU's name and logo will appear on all ten signs. To be installed in August 2022. Artwork is under development, CUSP has CCTU artwork for incorporation on

- the signs. Work is in progress; still waiting to hear from CUSP CUSP and Denver Water are fussing; there may be no sign nothing new (no change in status)
- Lower Gill Trail: USFS has acknowledged that the Gill Trail needs restoration work performed to lessen the
 amount of erosion happening due to natural events and greater usage. Denver Water has agreed to partner
 with the USFS for their portion of the trail improvements. CCTU will be in the loop as this project develops.
 CCTU has submitted this stretch of river as our "Priority Waters" to CTU This remains a continuing effort
 - Feasibility studies will cost \$80-100K; can't move on without that money.
 - Grant proposal was approved by the SPEB on July 22 in the amount of \$40k (restricted funds)
 - Denver Water/USFS have provided SPEB notice that they would pick up any remaining funding with a SPEB Grant Award of \$40k. Denver Water offered an additional \$100K if the grant is approved
- O Wigwam Creek Bridge Repair: The USFS "Collection Agreement" between the Forestry Service and CCTU has been executed. All parties have signed the document and the funds to repair the bridge have been provided to the USFS. Once the foundations have been replaced/repaired the bridge will be placed back. There potentially could be some need for volunteers for this event. Won't occur until after runoff nothing done so far No change in status. John will check with USFS on when this project will start
- TU Orphan Boy Mine Project Design fees for the Mine restoration project \$5,500.00 were provided John E visited the sight in June. John E met with Lauren Dunken at TU to organize. This project needs more money and plans. John E will assume leadership
- Urad Lake clinic and cleanup 8/14; Brian to organize. There are enough volunteers signed up to proceed with this
 event
